Compulsory REVISION comments	Helicobacter pylori (HP) is one of the most common chronic bacterial infections in the world. More than half of the world's population has HP colonization. The seroprevalence rate of HP was estimated to be 33 %. It is a common microorganism found with a frequency of 80 % in developing countries. HP causes chronic inflammation in the stomach and elicits immune response. Most of the patients are usually asymptomatic. Why did the authors not evaluate the gastric biopsies for helicobacter pylori infection? If the study was done evaluating biopsy, it would be better.	
Minor REVISION comments	The recent articles about helicobacter pylori infection in children should be cited. For example Arch Argent Pediatr 2020; 118: e241-e245.
